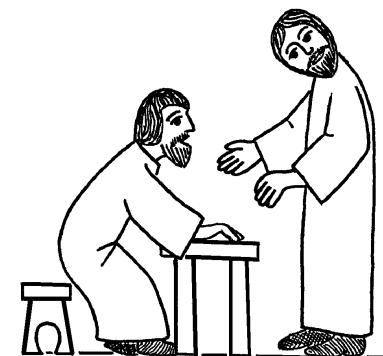

## CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) PRECAUTIONS

This will mean we need to open for limited periods, and with some systems implemented. So we will remain closed for a short while longer while we get everything into place, and because of the need for some tidying up of the floor, it is most unlikely to be anytime in July.
