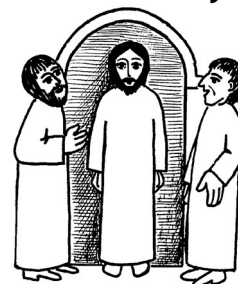

## WORSHIP IN CHURCH

The following rules apply to all attending worship:

- (1) We encourage you to wear your masks – they protect those around us from air-borne particles. **HOWEVER, face coverings MUST be worn when approaching the priest at communion. Please remain seated, if you are unwilling to do this.**
- (2) The porch door and sacristy doors will remain open, please dress accordingly for a cool breeze.
- (3) Hymns can be sung without your masks on, but please wear them if you are in close proximity to someone.
- (4) Anti-bac **STILL** to be used on entry and exit, prior to **and after** communion
- (5) Communion will now be administered at the altar rail – please do not crowd one another.
